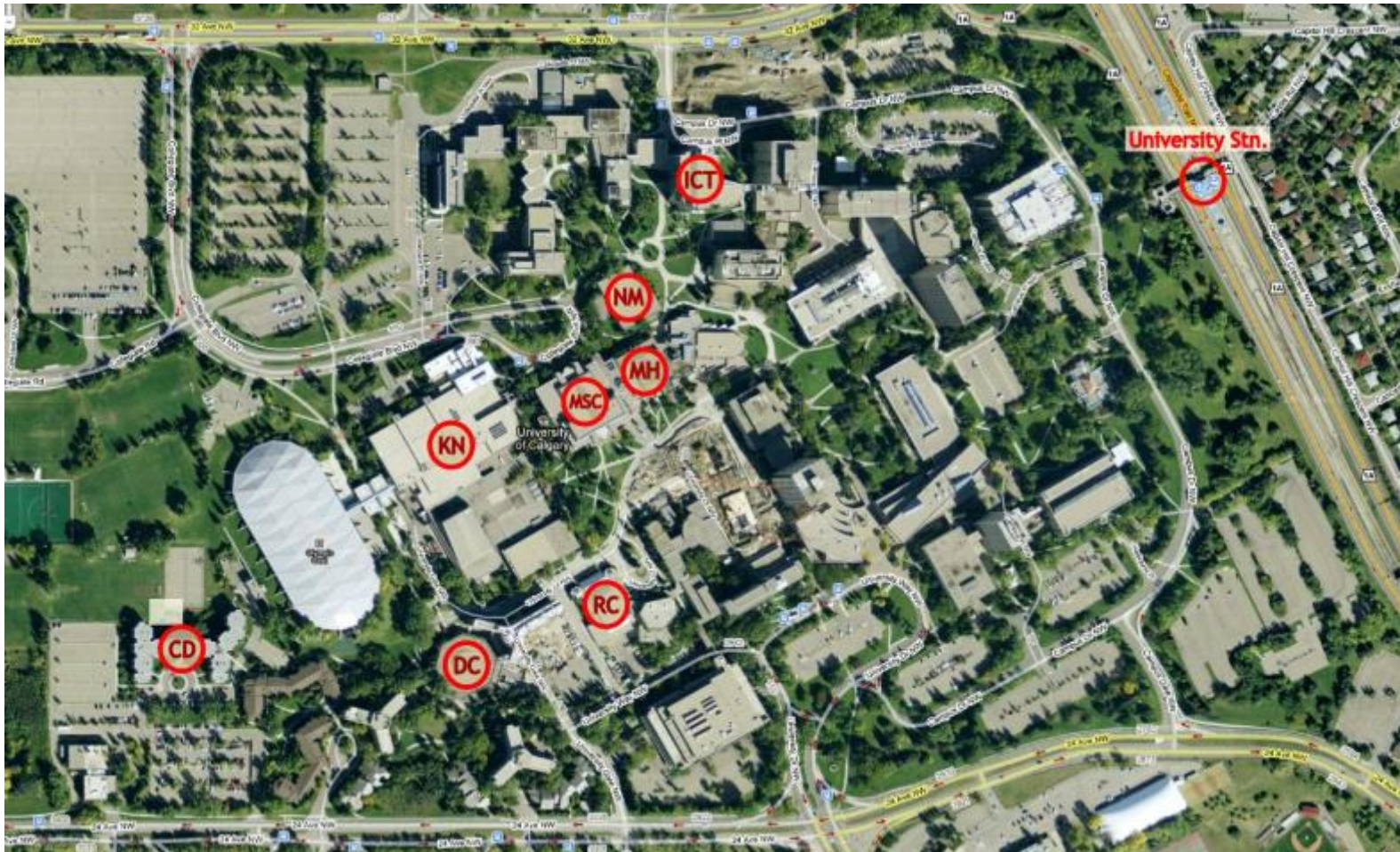

Footnotes

- Canadian Student status includes: a) Canadian Citizens; b) Landed Immigrants and Permanent Residents; c) the dependents of foreign Consular officials.
- The undergraduate tuition for a quarter-course (1.5 units) is \$269.30 and \$134.65 for an eighth-course (.75 units).
- International Student Differential: Undergraduate - .200% of the international base tuition fee.
- Tuition fees in the Faculty of Law are assessed on a per-course basis. The tuition fee for one course is \$1,026.24.
- Universal Bus Pass, Spring/Summer UPASS was introduced in 2012 for full-time students. The 2014 rate is \$120.
- Students may opt out with comparable coverage by deadline.
- Students may opt out.
- Engineering Student Society (ESS) fees: Full-time Engineering Students pay a mandatory \$10.00 fee per term. In addition, a \$25.00 per term optional levy (students may opt out) is included for every undergraduate engineering student.
- Spring or Summer Terms: full-time status is two half courses (two 3 unit courses). Part-time status is one half course (one 3 unit course).
- Mandatory \$75.00 per term fee for all Law students.
- A Student Services Fee of \$225.00 per term for full-time students and \$75.00 per term for part-time students (provided for Spring and Summer Terms) has been approved. See P.1.13.3 for more information on this fee.
- An additional \$238.83 will be assessed for 200-, 300-, 400- and 500-level Commerce courses (including TOUR). The cost for 1 half course (3 units) is \$777.62. International students pay \$2,072.87 per 1 half course (3 units). See P.1.12 for more information on this fee.
